

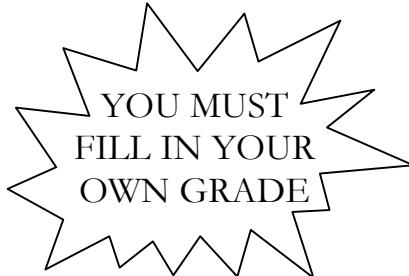
**Math Thanks**

- The words have to use the mathematical meaning as well. (For example, if you use the word mean, it must stand for average)
- As you write your poem, keep in mind your audience: myself as well as your fellow classmates.
- **You will evaluate your own work by completing this rubric and handing it in with your poem.**
- Failure to hand in this form with your poem will be a 5 point deduction. If you hand in this form, but do not completely fill it out, there will be a 2 point deduction.
- This poem is due at the *beginning* of the period on **FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4TH.**
- **You may turn it in at any time before then.**
